The Bella Stage

The exhibitor list has been published on <u>program.bogforum.dk.</u> If you have not yet created or updated your exhibitor page, please do so as soon as possible.

If your exhibitor page is not created/updated by **Sunday, 31 August**, your registered VAT company name will appear in the exhibitor list (both online and in the printed program) – and any exhibitor page information from last year will be deleted (online).

The program and full exhibitor pages will be published on Monday, 1 September, so if you want your authors/stage participants and booths activities to appear in the program at launch, you must enter them before then.

Bogforum's Printed Program Catalogue

This year, Bogforum has once again partnered with StoryLab for the development and production of our printed program.

The program will be around 120 pages and take the form of a magazine. In addition to the official program (which contains all events on Bogforum's official stages), the magazine will include articles, features, other book-related content, as well as adverts and paid content. Read more here.

Distribution will follow last year's model: to bookshops and libraries across the country, handed out at Bogforum, and in a 15,000-copy run as a bundled supplement with *Alt for damerne* and *Eurowoman*.

This year, program texts will be sent directly for proofreading to the participating authors and moderators. Once approved, the texts will then be sent to the publishers for information.

Signings

Signing tables will be set up at the following stages: Store Scene, Litteraturscenen, Vidensscenen, Perspektivscenen, Krimiscenen, Temascenen, Balkonscenen, and Atelieret.
